Project-Based Learning

A successful project gives a specific challenge, problem, scenario or dilemma.

The mentor and the student work on a solution to assist with the development of important skills. The project can last up to ten weeks and create an experience that is as robust as an internship.

Here are examples of successful projects:

- Research and write grant proposals for local cultural programs
- · Participate in summer business camps to develop start-up plans for new business
- Taking on the responsibility for the financial records for a community music festival
- Involve the students in firm-sponsored charitable activities
